# Welcome

- The organising committee of the Welsh Airgun Championships look forward to welcoming you to Cardiff later this week.
- We have introduced a number of procedures this year to ensure adherence to Welsh Government regulation and our hosts, Sport Wales National Centre, local operating procedures.
- Please read the following guidance carefully if you have any questions please look first at the WTFSF website as we expect many questions will be repeated and we will create a FAQ.

# Covid Safety

- It is mandatory for athletes to complete, prior to your arrival, a lateral flow test. Bring the test cassette with you, showing a negative test, and you will be given a coloured wristband which will give you access for 2 days.
- Before arriving on your day 3, carry out another test and bring the cassette with you, showing a negative test, and you will be given another coloured wristband.
- Ensure you bring adequate number of test kits with you.
- If you need kits, order from <https://www.gov.uk/order-coronavirus-rapid-lateral-flow-tests> delivery is 1 to 2 days.
- In addition, each day on arrival, your temperature will be checked and you will be asked to complete a self declaration covid status questionnaire.
- It is mandatory to wear facemasks in Sport Wales at all times unless you are eating or drinking. Athletes do not need to wear masks when on the firing line.
- We ask that you use hand sanitiser on entry and as you move around the building at the sanitiser points. There are many around Sport Wales.
- Maintain social distancing. Shooting lanes in the main hall will be at 1m distance but there will be clear protective screens between each lane.

# Registration and range procedures

- Entry to Sport Wales for athletes will be through the side entrance which is on the cricket ground side of the building.
- On arrival, after you have completed the covid checks, collect your accreditation from the reception area just inside the entrance.
- You will need your accreditation and a correct colour wristband on display at all times.
- The schedule is at the end of this brief.
- On Thursday, reception is open from 11:00 to allow you plenty of time to register. Equipment control is open at 12:00 and unofficial training starts from 13:00. We will monitor numbers of people and ask you to move elsewhere if social distancing is compromised. Unofficial training ends at 19:00.
- There will be 40 targets in the main hall.
- Once you have finished your unofficial training please leave the main hall.
- Lanes 31 to 40 will be unavailable from 15:30 to 17:45 for unofficial training due to athletes competing in the R3 and R5 competitions.
- On Friday, Saturday and Sunday access to the building and to the athlete preparation area is from 1 hour before your call to the line time.

# Registration and range procedures cont.

- Arrival times at the reception for entry to the building is from:
  - Detail 1 – 07:15 (CTL 08:15)
  - Detail 2 – 09:20 (CTL 10:20)
  - Detail 3 – 11:25 (CTL 12:25)
  - Detail 4 – 13:30 (CTL 14:30)
- Equipment control is not mandatory. If you want your equipment checked, equipment control will be in the Jubilee Hall at the time specified in the schedule.
- Random equipment checks will be carried out after each qualification match.
- There is a designated area in the main hall for athlete preparation. You will remain in this area until you are called to the line. Masks are to be worn until you are on the firing point.
- When the qualification match has ended please remove your equipment as quickly as possible.
- You must take all equipment with you when you leave the main hall.
- Result screens will be in the main hall and official result sheets and your printouts will be in the reception area.
- Reporting time for the first final will be 35 minutes after the end of the qualification match.

# Finals

- Finals will be in the Jubilee Hall. There will be separate finals for seniors and juniors after each qualification match.
- The reporting time for the first final will be 35 minutes after the end of the match
- The reporting time for the second final will be 1 hour and 35 minutes after the match.
- Firing points will be distanced from each other so that protective screens are not needed.
- The finals will be live streamed on You Tube [see a short intro](#) please subscribe and share.
- Medal ceremonies will be immediately after each final.
