# Welcome

- The organising committee of the Welsh Airgun Championships look forward to welcoming you to Cardiff later this week.
- We have introduced a number of procedures this year to ensure adherence to Welsh Government regulation and our hosts, Sport Wales National Centre, local operating procedures.
- Our primary goal is to run an enjoyable and safe Championships for the athletes.
- We are reliant on you to help us achieve this.
- Please read the following guidance carefully if you have any questions please look first at the WTSF website as we expect many questions will be repeated and we will create a FAQ.

# Covid Safety

- It is mandatory for coaches to complete, prior to your arrival, a lateral flow test. Bring the test cassette with you, showing a negative test, and you will be given a coloured wristband which will give you access for 2 days.
- Before arriving on your day 3, carry out another test and bring the cassette with you, showing a negative test, and you will be given another coloured wristband.
- Ensure you bring adequate number of test kits with you.
- If you need kits, order from <https://www.gov.uk/order-coronavirus-rapid-lateral-flow-tests> delivery is 1 to 2 days.
- In addition, each day on arrival, your temperature will be checked and you will be asked to complete a self declaration covid status questionnaire.
- It is mandatory to wear facemasks in Sport Wales at all times unless you are eating or drinking.
- We ask that you use hand sanitiser on entry and as you move around the building at the sanitiser points. There are many around Sport Wales.
- Maintain social distancing as far as is practically possible.

# Registration and range procedures

- Entry to Sport Wales for coaches will be through the side entrance which is on the cricket ground side of the building.
- On arrival, after you have completed the covid checks, collect your accreditation from the reception area just inside the entrance.
- You will need your accreditation and a correct colour wristband on display at all times.
- On Thursday, reception is open from 11:00 to allow you plenty of time to register and assist your athletes through equipment control if needed. Equipment control is open at 12:00 and unofficial training starts from 13:00. We will monitor numbers of people and ask you to move elsewhere if social distancing is compromised. Unofficial training ends at 19:00.
- Once the athletes you are coaching have finished their unofficial training please leave the main hall.
- On Friday, Saturday and Sunday access to the building will be from 1 hour before your athletes call to the line time.

# Registration and range procedures cont.

- Arrival times at the reception for entry to the building is from:
  - Detail 1 – 07:15 (CTL 08:15)
  - Detail 2 – 09:20 (CTL 10:20)
  - Detail 3 – 11:25 (CTL 12:25)
  - Detail 4 – 13:30 (CTL 14:30)
- When the qualification match has ended please help us by not debriefing athletes immediately but help them to clear the firing line as quickly as possible.
- Result screens will be in the main hall and official result sheets will be in the reception area. Results will be live streamed and there is free Wi-Fi in the sport centre. Please be mindful of social distancing in 'pinch points'
- Reporting time for the first final will be 35 minutes after the end of the qualification match. Please ensure your athletes are aware.

# Finals & Spectators

- Finals will be in the Jubilee Hall. There will be separate finals for seniors and juniors after each qualification match.
- The reporting time for the first final will be 35 minutes after the end of the match
- The reporting time for the second final will be 1 hour and 35 minutes after the match.
- There will be an allocated seat on the field of play for 1 coach for each athlete.
- The finals will be live streamed on You Tube [see a short intro](#) please subscribe and share.
- Medal ceremonies will be immediately after each final.

## Spectators

- Spectators will be allowed and they do not need to have a lateral flow test. Access to Sport Wales will be through the main reception
- For the qualification matches the galleries on level 1 and 2 will be used to view the main hall and spectators will be allowed in the Jubilee Hall for the finals.
- There has been multiple coach applications for some athletes. The number of coach accreditations will likely mean that the main hall will exceed capacity, especially during pistol competitions. If necessary an announcement will be made, and we politely ask that coaches who are not directly coaching at that time leave the main hall and view as a spectator.
