
Athlete Guidance



Welcome

- The organising committee of the Welsh Airgun Championships look forward to welcoming you to Cardiff later this week.

- We understand there are now no Covid-19 rules or regulations.
- There is no requirement to wear facemasks in Sport Wales nor is it necessary to socially distance from one another. However, we ask you to be respectful of others space and keep your distance if you are feeling unwell.
- This year there is a change in the format due to the length of time the new finals take to run.
- It is not possible to fit 8 finals in a day.
- Sunday will be an open competition where there will be no separate competitions for juniors.

We would also like to make you aware that parking at Sport Wales on Saturday 5th may be limited due to the rugby.

Registration and range procedures

- Entry to Sport Wales for the event will be through the side entrance which is on the cricket ground side
 of the building.
- On arrival, collect your accreditation and bib number from the reception area just inside the entrance.
- Please wear your accreditation when in the sport centre.
- On Thursday, reception and equipment control are open from 15:00 and unofficial training starts from 16:00. Unofficial training ends at 20:00.
- There will be 52 targets in the main hall.
- Lanes 34 to 52 will be unavailable from 16:00 to 19:00 for unofficial training due to athletes competing
 in the R3, R4, and R5 competitions.
- The schedule is on our website. We will update it with any changes before the event.
- Equipment control is not mandatory. If you want your equipment checked, equipment control will be in the Jubilee Hall at the time specified in the schedule.
- Random equipment checks will be carried out after each qualification match.
- There will be a designated area in the main hall for athlete preparation where dry firing can take place.
- When the qualification match has ended please remove your equipment as quickly as possible. From the firing point and the hall.
- Result screens will be in the main hall and official result sheets will be in the reception area.

Pairs Competition

- The pairs competition has been introduced this year to provide finals opportunities on the days of the Cardiff Grand Prix.
- The draw will take place on Thursday 27th October 7pm live on Facebook, we will produce a list of names that will be sent out to all mixed pairs participants.
- The athletes drawn to make up a pair will be final.
- If there is an overflow of athletes in the male or female category, names will continue to be drawn from the remaining athletes which will form pairs of the same gender.
- If there is an odd number of athletes in the discipline being drawn, the remaining athlete will become a reserve.
- The qualification match will be concurrent with the first 30 shots of the Cardiff Grand Prix competition.
- The top 2 placed pairs will progress to the Gold and Silver medal final. The pairs placed 3rd and 4th will progress to the Bronze medal match.

Finals

- Finals will be in the Jubilee Hall.
- Friday there will be finals for seniors for the AirOShoot quota places and juniors will have their pairs final.
- Saturday there will be finals for juniors for the AirOShoot quota places and seniors will have their pairs final.
- Sunday the finals will be for the Open Championship.

- Medal ceremonies will be immediately after each final.
- The medal ceremony for the Cardiff GP will be after the pairs final
